

BIDDING IS NOW OPEN



This painting of the original Silver Bridge, Strathavon by Rosemary Bushell has been donated to support CLAN Cancer support.

In May this year a very successful exhibition and sale took place of the works of art by Rosemary in aid of Marie Curie. This was held at Logie Steading and raised over £5,500.

Recently the above unframed watercolour of the original Silver Bridge came to light in The Gallery in Aberlour and is now offered for sale in aid of CLAN Cancer Support.

The bridge was replaced in 1998 which necessitated the road being closed for several weeks, which must have been a great inconvenience for the local farmers. Rosemary remembers that it had been hoped that the new bridge could be a replica of the old with its characteristic shallow iron work arch. This was perhaps too expensive and a bailey bridge was put in place instead.

An opening ceremony took place on 18th December 1998 with local councillors present.
